## **NETBALL**

### **Y3,4,5 & 6**

Our teams play in the Future Ferns program run by Auckland Netball at the Auckland Netball Centre, Morrin Road. Games are on a Thursday afternoon. Future Ferns is an introduction to netball using equipment and rules which are adapted to suit player size. Children rotate positions throughout the season allowing development of knowledge of all playing positions. The season runs from end of March until late August (except in school holidays). Both girls and boys are encouraged to play netball. Cost for the season is \$145.

### **Y1 & 2**

We are hoping to register a team in the Y1 and 2 league this season. This is a skills based program, run on the inside courts at Auckland Netball, Thursdays from 4.15 – 5.00. This is a great program to introduce the children to netball and also keeps them occupied while their siblings are playing their game outside. ## Letter to Parents

### After Schools Badminton Program

The 'Smash It' program for 2009 was a success. With a noticeable improvement to the children who have participated in the program.

We will be continuing with this program for 2010.

This will be held at 3.30pm to 4.30pm on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> February at the school gym for at least 6 weeks.

#### **Sessions**

A teacher or parent will also be present during each coaching session.

Children will also be taught how to smash and do trick shots as well having fun playing with other students.

For most of the session there will be fun games and a chance for players to play against each other.

#### **Cost**

The cost of this program is \$50 per term per student.

The students will also be registered with Auckland Badminton and if they join a club \$10 will come off their membership fee as the club will not have to affiliate them.

#### **Web Page**

Each school will have a web page on the Auckland Badminton website so that the group can be promoted and you can view to see if there are any playing groups in the program in secondary schools so your child may be able to keep playing.

#### **Talent Scout**

We will also talent scout in each school to identify talented players who may be able to join our talent development programs.

### **Club Link**

Clubs will also be free to – should they choose – offer the students discounted club rates – if the club is full – but allow the children to play interclub for the club so the school group is set up as a miniature or satellite club. This is to allow children to access the sport instead of being turned away. If the child has played two terms they will be fully affiliated so the club will not have to pay the \$45 fee normally associated with a child playing interclub for Auckland.

The club and school will also have a partnership where the club will apply for funding to help resource the school with badminton equipment.

### **Numbers**

We need 20 children to start a group – playing numbers per group will be kept to a 20 to 1 player to coach ratio to ensure the sessions are fun and interesting. Each coach will have received training from Auckland Badminton on the program which has been designed by Auckland's leading high performance coaches.

### **Coach Training**

We also offer free training in the program for any parent or teacher wishing to learn how to coach in the program. Jobs eventually may be available in the school or feeder schools but will depend on the speed of learning and suitability of the person involved.
